**News and Notes on QuickBooks** - Now is a great time to upgrade your QuickBooks to the newest version – 2010. QuickBooks discontinued supporting QuickBooks 2006 in June, 2009 and will discontinue 2007 in June, 2010. What does this mean? If you are running one of these older versions and have a question, QuickBooks will not help you. What? QuickBooks does not continue to train their employees on the older versions. This said, they do not support the older versions. Not even for the simplest questions

The conversion to a new version is quick and easy. Once the new version is loaded on your computer, you just open your current data file in the new version. It is that easy.

The end of the year is a great time to update. This allows you to start the New Year off fresh.

**QuickBooks 2009 Update – It is Important to Run the Update** - QuickBooks released an update (R9) as an “Automatic Update” on December 1<sup>st</sup>. If the update is not run and you send a backup to us for the completion of your tax return, we will not be able to send the changes back to you.
